Participants will learn how to assist individuals on the pathway to citizenship. This program will focus on the eligibility, law and process for legal permanent residents to apply for citizenship using the U.S. Citizenship Application Form N-400. Developed by immigration law practitioners, the program is intended to provide the essentials needed to conduct an eligibility review and provide legal advice on completing the Form N-400.

Topics include:

- Naturalization eligibility requirements
- Naturalization process and information required to complete Form N-400
- Attorney ethics and application assistance

After the workshop, volunteers (attorneys and non-attorneys) are needed for the naturalization application assistance event from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The CLE registration fee will be waived for volunteers (use promo code VOL727).
